Conversational English (Week 1)

Students will study a taste of the English programs at Swinburne. The program will focus on improving students' speaking and communication skills, including enhancing their English vocabulary and learning useful phrases and expressions for daily conversations. This course is interactive and group discussions are vital part of our learning and teaching.

English for Global Business Cultures (Week 2)

In preparation to their academic lecture, English classes in week 2 will be focused on multiculturalism, including new vocabulary and exchange of ideas in the topic.

Academic Lecture and Workshop

This session will introduce students to business etiquettes in different cultural environments, giving them a cross-cultural awareness and understanding of how this affects how international business operates.

Activities

Students will be offered a range of activities during the program, which will complement the program, including:

Discussion session with local students/Buddy meet-up

In this session, international students will be joined by Swinburne local students, to discuss selected topics, where they will be able to share their ideas and points of views from different cross-cultural perspectives.

Virtual City Tours & Campus tour at Swinburne

Students will visit Melbourne's must-see spots in CBD virtually, including a virtual tour of National Gallery of Victoria. (*depending on the availability, the program is subject to change.) A Swinburne staff member will also take them to a virtual campus tour and talk about student life at Swinburne.

Weekly activities with ELICOS students

International students who join our English programs (ELICOS) at Swinburne will have access to our online activities. This provides them a best way to meet other students and make friends with students from all over the world. Students who attend this short online program will have access to join these activities for free, and meet our international students.

Virtual Homestay with AHN (Optional)

Virtual homestay is a new authentic way to discover Australia. Students will experience Australian lifestyle and culture while engaging activities that connect Australian families. Students will talk about their daily life at home and can introduce each other's family and cook their favourite dishes together in the kitchen. Both the hosts and the students share the online experience, learn about different cultures, and make new friends. Students can also learn or improve their English and prepare for studying abroad.
