**GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS
FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2017**

Admission Policy

The basic philosophy of this graduate school is to promote education and research in agriculture, engineering and related fields and contribute to the survival and prosperity of humans and the sustainment of the beautiful earth.

Facing growing problems associated with the expansion of various human activities such as food and resource problems, environmental and pollution problems and population problem, this faculty aims at (1) producing expertise on life, biofunction, environment, information, humanities and social sciences indispensable to solve population, food, resource and environmental problems of the 21st century, (2) producing broad expertise for deep resolution and insight on nature, humans, society and culture, (3) producing abilities to solve the problems with the issue exploring ability by using mission intending science in response to request from society, (4) producing abilities to play an active role in international society in a leadership position and (5) sustaining and improving enthusiasm for personal development and producing extremely advanced enthusiasm for education and research.

For the objectives above, we accept students from home and abroad who meet the university's required academic level and aspire to contribute to society by becoming specialists and researchers in fields related to agriscience, bioscience and ecoscience.

Our graduate school, Tokyo University of Agriculture and Technology, hereinafter referred to as "TUAT", offers a special course "Program for highly professional engineers and researchers leading sustainable agricultural development" in Department of International Environmental Agriculture Science (IEAS), and recruits international students who study related to environmental and agricultural science as following conditions.

I. Fields of Study

- International Environmental Rehabilitation and Conservation
- International Biological Production and Resource Science
- International Development on Rural Areas
- Double Degree Program (International Environmental and Agricultural Science)

II. Number of students to be admitted and Course description

This course consists of three programs: (1) For the students who is from the countries which the Japanese Government Scholarships are offered. (2) For the students who want to earn a master's degree of TUAT with private funds. (3) For the students who want to earn two master's degree both of TUAT and their country's university with private funds.

(1) Students who are recommended for the Japanese Government Scholarship

Appropriate number of students will be selected for admission. Then the graduate school will recommend **seven students** as candidates for Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho: MEXT) Scholarship – hereinafter referred to as “Scholarship”.

(2) Students of Private Funds (those who want to earn a master's degree at TUAT)

Alternatively, **a few students** will be selected from those who are on other sorts of financial support – hereinafter referred to as “Private Funds”.

(3) Students of Private Funds (those who want to take DDP)

This program is called Double Degree Program – hereinafter referred to as “DDP”, based on the memorandum between TUAT and a foreign graduate school. Therefore, those applicants to DDP need to be admitted to the foreign graduate school beforehand.

Pay attention to each Qualification and Application Procedure, since three programs have several different conditions.

III. Eligibility and Requirement

- (1) Students who are recommended for Scholarship: See pages iii to vii.
- (2) Students of Private Funds (those who want to earn a master's degree at TUAT): See pages viii to x.
- (3) Students of Private Funds (those who want to take DDP): See pages xi to xiii.

(1) Students who are recommended for Scholarship

1. Candidates

Graduate-level international applicants who will enter to Japan as new students.

2. Nationality

Applicants must have the nationality of a country with diplomatic relations with the Japanese government. Applicants who have Japanese nationality at the time of application are ineligible.

3. Age

Applicants who were born on or after April 2, 1982.

4. Academic background

Applicants must be a graduate of a Japanese university or have academic abilities equivalent to or greater than that of a Japanese university graduate. Eligible applicants other than those who have graduated from Japanese universities are defined as follows:

- 1) Applicants who have completed (or expected to complete) 16 years of school education outside Japan.
- 2) Applicants who have been recognized as having equal academic ability to university graduate level by TUAT in individual entrance qualification screening process. And applicants who have reached (or expected to reach) 22 years of age.

5. Health

Applicants should be in good mental and physical health.

6. Language skill

Good working level of knowledge in English is required.

7. Arrival in Japan

Applicants must be able to arrive in Japan between September 18 and October 7, 2017.

8. Remarks

1) Applicants in the following categories are “ineligible” for the Japanese Government Scholarship. They must decline the scholarship offer if they are found to fit any of the following criteria upon their selection.

- (1) Active member of the military or civilian employed by the military;
- (2) Applicant who is unable to travel to Japan within the period designated by the host university;
- (3) Former recipient of a Japanese Government Scholarship in the past is ineligible unless he or she has at least three years of education and/or research records at the time of the selection for the new scholarship, counted from the completion of their previous scholarship. This does not apply to a research-student applicant,

who: (i) received training as a Japanese-studies student and later returned to a university from which he or she graduated in their home or another country; or (ii) was an international student in Japan under the Japan-Korea Joint Government Scholarship Program for the Students in Science and Engineering Departments and later returned to South Korea; or (iii) was an international student under the young leaders program.

- (4) A recipient of a scholarship from an organization (including a governmental organization in his or her home country) other than the Japanese government (MEXT)
 - (5) An applicant who has concurrently applied for this scholarship through another university's recommendation, or an applicant who has applied for other scholarships for international students by the Japanese government (MEXT) or the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) (including students who have been awarded these scholarships and who plan to remain enrolled in the semester beginning in October 2017 and beyond.)
 - (6) An applicant who lives or plans to live in Japan prior to the beginning of the 2017 all semester.
- 2) Admission shall be canceled if a candidate who expected to graduate failed his/her graduation until the end of September 2017.
 - 3) For students regarding "III Eligibility and Requirement, 4. Academic background", in case the candidate has less than 16 years of school education, evaluation is required prior to the admission. Please inform your prospective supervisor at TUAT by January 11, 2017.

Application Procedure

Applicants should go through their university or institution to submit the following documents before January 28, 2017.

- 1) Submittal
All the documents should be sent by a registered mail to the prospective supervisor. (The applicant should contact the prospective supervisor and obtain an acceptance from him or her in advance.)
- 2) Documents to be submitted
 - (1) JAPANESE GOVERNMENT (MONBUKAGAKUSHO: MEXT) SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2017 (use enclosed form)
 - (2) Field of your major and research plan (use enclosed form)
 - (3) A Certificate of health (use enclosed form and this certificate should be obtained within the past 6 months before the submission.)

- (4) Original diploma or certificate for (prospected) graduation issued by the last university attended (undergraduate or graduate school), indicating the degree conferred. (Diploma will be returned.)
- (5) Original academic transcript issued by the last university attended (undergraduate or graduate school.)
- (6) A certification that shows the applicant's birth, nationality, citizenship, or residence in the applicant's home country such as a transcription of domiciliary register or a proof of citizenship.
- (7) A letter of recommendation, by the dean or head of the applicant's affiliated institution. This letter is addressed to the president of Tokyo University of Agriculture and Technology. Please use the envelope issued by your university and an official seal of your university.
- (8) Your photograph of passport size (4.5cm by 3.5cm), showing a clear front-faced, up-from-bust, bare-headed picture, taken within 6 months of the application date. Name and nationality should be printed on the back side. Photograph should be attached to the designated place of the application form.
- (9) An abstract of either Bachelor's or Master's thesis, or equivalent paper in Japanese or English within 600 words.
- (10) Original of the academic certificate of the last university attended showing the GPA or the ranking which the applicant has been awarded within his or her class (e.g. Xth out of Y students.)
- (11) Original certificate for language (e.g. TOEFL, TOEIC, Japanese Language Proficiency Test etc.)
- (12) Research Achievement
- (13) A photocopy of passport (If you have already your passport. The pages where the name and the photograph can be identified)

3) Remarks

- i) All the documents should be typewritten in either English or Japanese and printed in A4 size with enclosed form. (In the case the document is not English or Japanese, please attach the translation in English or Japanese with it.)
- ii) The submitted documents will not be returned
- iii) All documents should be correctly completed and submitted before the deadline. Documents submitted after the deadline and incomplete applications will not be considered.
- iv) The documents and form is possible to change.

4) Screening and aim of this Special Course

- i) Candidates recommended by TUAT will pass through MEXT selection and the result will be notified to TUAT.
- ii) TUAT will inform the result to the candidates by June, 2017.
- iii) The classes and instruction is conducted in English mainly and this program offers a Master of Agriculture or a Master of Philosophy within 2 years. The enrollment identification is a full time master course student.

5) Allowance

The scholarship duration for MEXT Scholarship recipients is twenty-four (24) months from October, 2017.

The amount of the monthly stipend for 2017 is yet to be determined. For reference, the monthly amount for 2016 scholarship was JPY144,000/month (This amount is subject to change depending on the size of annual fiscal budget, price of commodities, etc. for each year).

The scholarship will not be paid to a recipient who is on a leave of absence or absent for a long period from his or her university. The scholarship will be cancelled in the following cases:

- i) If any portion of the recipient's application documents is found to be falsely stated.
- ii) If the recipient is in breach of his or her pledge made to the Minister of MEXT.
- iii) If the recipient is subjected to a disciplinary action or expulsion by his or her university.
- iv) If it is determined that the recipient will not be able to complete his or her course within the standard course term because of his or her poor academic achievement or suspension.
- v) If the recipient leaves the host university or transfers to another graduate school.
- vi) If the recipient changes his or her resident status of "Exchange Student," as provided for in Paragraph 1-4 of Appendix to the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act, to any other status.
- vii) If the recipient receives another scholarship (except for a scholarship designated for research expenses).

6) Traveling Costs

- i) Transportation to Japan: Recipients will be provided, according to the itinerary and route designated for them by MEXT, with an economy class air ticket from the international airport closest to their place of residence to Narita International Airport (or an international airport the recipient's host university normally uses).
Recipients will have to shoulder expenses such as domestic transportation from their place of residence to the nearest international airport, passenger service facilities charge (PSFC), airport taxes, special taxes on overseas travel and domestic travel expenses in Japan (basically the recipient's place of residence should be the current address stated in the application form). Moreover, an air ticket will not be provided if the recipient travels to Japan from a country other than that of his or her nationality.
- ii) Transportation from Japan: Upon application, recipients who wish to return to their home country within the last-payment month of the scholarship will be provided with an economy class air ticket for a flight from Narita International Airport (or an international airport the recipient's university normally uses) to the international airport closest to their place of return.
- iii) Recipient should bare the cost of travel insurance for his/her travels to/from Japan.

7) Cost of Insurance at the Enrollment

- i) School fees including application fee, admission fee and tuition fee will not be charged.
- ii) Personal injury insurance which insures them against unforeseen accidents and injuries (but not illnesses) sustained in curricular (in class) activities, at school events, during club activities, or while they are in or on their way to or from a university facility. The expense is 1,750 Japanese Yen for 2years.
- iii) Student Liability Insurance Program which will provide compensation in the event that the student injures another person or damages another person's property during the course of teaching training, care practice, internship, volunteer activities, off-campus research (surveys, tours, training), museum curator training, or extracurricular activities (such as overnight field trips and expeditions). All the enrolling students are required to join the Student Liability Insurance Program in addition to the Students Education and Research Accident Insurance.

The cost of the both insurance is 2,480 Japanese Yen for 2 years. Also a member fee for the University Co-op of 5,000 yen, which will be reimbursed at the end of the Master's program, is required. * The costs of the insurance fee and the member fee for the University Co-op are subject to change.

(2) Students of Private Funds
(those who want to earn a master's degree at TUAT)

1. Candidates
Students can already be residing in Japan at the moment of application.
2. Nationality
No nationality requirements.
3. Age
No restriction.
4. Academic background
Applicants must be a graduate of a Japanese university or have academic abilities equivalent to or greater than that of a Japanese university graduate. Eligible applicants other than those who have graduated from Japanese universities are defined as follows:
 - 1) Applicants who have completed (or expected to complete) 16 years of school education outside Japan.
 - 2) Applicants who have been recognized as having equal academic ability to university graduate level by TUAT in individual entrance qualification screening process. And applicants who have reached (or expected to reach) 22 years of age.
5. Health
Applicants should be in good mental and physical health.
6. Language skill
Good working level of knowledge in English is required.
7. Arrival in Japan
Applicants must be able to arrive in Japan between September 18 and October 7, 2017.
8. Other remarks
 - 1) Admission shall be canceled if a candidate who expected to graduate failed his/her graduation until the end of September 2017.
 - 2) For students regarding "III Eligibility and Requirement, 4. Academic background", in case the candidate has less than 16 years of school education, evaluation is required prior to the admission. Please inform your prospective supervisor at TUAT by February 8, 2017.

Application Procedure

Applicants should go through their university or institution to submit the following documents before March 25, 2017.

(All the applicants must apply upon the acceptance from prospective supervisor of the Department of International Environmental Agricultural Science after the discussion)

1) Submittal

All the documents should be sent by a registered mail to the prospective supervisor. (The applicant should contact the prospective supervisor and obtain an acceptance from him or her in advance.)

2) Documents to be submitted

- (1) 2017 academic year application form (use enclosed form)
- (2) Field of your major and research plan (use enclosed form)
- (3) A Certificate of health (use enclosed form and this certificate should be obtained within the past 6 months before the submission.)
- (4) Either a graduation certificate or a corresponding certificate issued by the applicant's school indicating that the applicant will be graduating from undergraduate or master's programs, which applicant lately graduated or graduating. A transcript of academic record and a degree certificate of undergraduate or master's programs that is issued by university authorities, which applicant lately graduated or graduating.
- (5) A certification that shows the applicant's birth, nationality, citizenship, or residence in the applicant's home country such as a transcription of domiciliary register or a proof of citizenship.
- (6) A letter of recommendation, by the dean or head of the applicant's affiliated institution. This letter is addressed to the president of Tokyo University of Agriculture and Technology. Please use the envelope issued by your university and an official seal of your university.
- (7) Your photograph of passport size (4.5cm by 3.5cm), showing a clear front-faced, up-from-bust, bare-headed picture, taken within 6 months of the application date. Name and nationality should be printed on the back side. Photograph should be attached to the designated place of the application form.
- (8) An abstract of either bachelor's or master's thesis, or equivalent paper in Japanese or English within 600 words.
- (9) A photocopy of passport (If you have already your passport. The pages where the name and the photograph can be identified)
- (10) Application fee of JPY 30,000
(to be paid by using the prescribed payment form at a Japanese post office.
Applicants outside Japan are advised to refer to their proposed supervisor for details)

3) Remarks

- i) All the documents should be typewritten in either English or Japanese and printed in A4 size with enclosed form. (In the case the document is not English or Japanese, please attach the translation in English or Japanese with it.)
- ii) The submitted documents will not be returned.

- iii) All documents should be correctly completed and submitted before the deadline. Documents submitted after the deadline and incomplete applications will not be considered.
 - iv) The documents and form is possible to change.
 - v) The prescribed payment form for Entrance examination fee can be requested from Educational Affairs Section II of Fuchu Student Support Office. Please request it early beforehand to avoid being late. After payment, please submit a receipt (right side of the money transfer bill) with application documents.
- 4) Screening and Aim of this Special Course
- i) The screening will be conducted based on the submitted documents in “IV Application Procedure”.
 - ii) The successful applicants are selected on a faculty meeting of Tokyo University of Agriculture and Technology and the notification of acceptance will be sent by the supervisor directly by the end of April, 2017.
 - iii) The classes and instruction is conducted in English mainly and this program offers a Master of Agriculture or a Master of Philosophy within 2 years. The enrollment identification is a full time master course student.
- 5) Cost and Insurance at the Enrollment
- i) Admission fee of JPY 282,000.
 - ii) Tuition fee for the fall semester (Oct. 2015 to Mar. 2016) is JPY 267,900 (JPY 535,800 per year). Tuition fee and admission fee will be adjusted at any time without notice.
 - iii) Personal injury insurance which insures them against unforeseen accidents and injuries (but not illnesses) sustained in curricular (in class) activities, at school events, during club activities, or while they are in or on their way to or from a university facility. The expense is JPY 1,750 for 2 years.
 - iv) Student Liability Insurance Program which will provide compensation in the event that the student injures another person or damages another person’s property during the course of teaching training, care practice, internship, volunteer activities, off-campus research (surveys, tours, training), museum curator training, or extracurricular activities (such as overnight field trips and expeditions). All the enrolling students are required to join the Student Liability Insurance Program in addition to the Students Education and Research Accident Insurance. The cost of the both insurance is JPY 2,480 for 2 years. Also a member fee for the University Co-op of JPY 5,000, which will be reimbursed at the end of the Master’s program, is required. *The costs of the insurance fee and the member fee for the University Co-op are subject to change.

4. Academic background

- 1) Applicants who have completed (or expected to complete) 16 years of school education outside Japan.
- 2) Applicants who have been recognized as having equal academic ability to university graduate level by TUAT in individual entrance qualification screening process. And applicants who have reached (or expected to reach) 22 years of age.
- 3) Applicants who have completed 15 years of school education outside Japan. And applicants who have been admitted as having superior score in requirement credits by TUAT

5. Health

Applicants should be in good mental and physical health.

6. Language skill

Good working level of knowledge in English is required.

7. Arrival in Japan

Applicants must arrive by the date specified by TUAT.

- 2) For students regarding III Eligibility and requirement 4 Academic background, in case the candidate has less than 16 years of school education, evaluation is required prior to the admission. Please inform your prospective supervisor at TUAT by February 5, 2017.

Application Procedure

The documents listed below should be submitted to the prospective supervisor during the application period. The application period is 1 July to 25 August, 2017. (The application must arrive in the mail by the last day)

All the documents should be submitted by the head of his/her graduate school if the applicant is a graduate school student; by the head of his/her institution or establishment if employed; or by the dean of the university from which he/she graduated if he/she presently has no formal academic affiliation. Personal applications are not accepted. (All the applicants must apply upon the acceptance from prospective supervisor of the Department of International Environmental Agricultural Science after the discussion)

1) Submittal

All the documents should be sent by a registered mail to the prospective supervisor. (The applicant should contact the prospective supervisor and obtain an acceptance from him or her in advance.)

3) Remarks

- i) All the documents should be typewritten in either English or Japanese and printed in A4 size with enclosed form.
- ii) The submitted documents will not be returned.
- iii) The Application will not be accepted unless all the documents mentioned above are appropriately filled and arrived on or before 25 August, 2017.
- iv) The documents and form is possible to change.

4) Screening and Aim of this Special Course

- i) The screening will be conducted based on the submitted documents in “IV Application Procedure”.
- ii) The successful applicants are selected on a faculty meeting of Tokyo University of Agriculture and Technology and the notification of acceptance will be sent by the supervisor directly by the end of September, 2017.
- iii) The classes and instruction is conducted in English mainly and this program offers a Master of Agriculture or a Master of Philosophy within 2 years. The enrollment identification is a full time master course student.

5) Cost of Insurance at the Enrollment

The students have to purchase casualty insurance for educational activities by students.

- i) Personal injury insurance which insures them against unforeseen accidents and injuries (but not illnesses) sustained in curricular (in class) activities, at school events, during club activities, or while they are in or on their way to or from a university facility. The expense is JPY 1,750 Japanese Yen for 2 years.
- ii) Student Liability Insurance Program which will provide compensation in the event that the student injures another person or damages another person’s property during the course of teaching training, care practice, internship, volunteer activities, off-campus research (surveys, tours, training), museum curator training, or extracurricular activities (such as overnight field trips and expeditions). All the enrolling students are required to join the Student Liability Insurance Program in addition to the Students Education and Research Accident Insurance. The cost of the both insurance is JPY 2,480 for 2 years. Also a member fee for the University Co-op of JPY 5,000, which will be reimbursed at the end of the Master’s program, is required. The costs of the insurance fee and the member fee for the University Co-op are subject to change.
